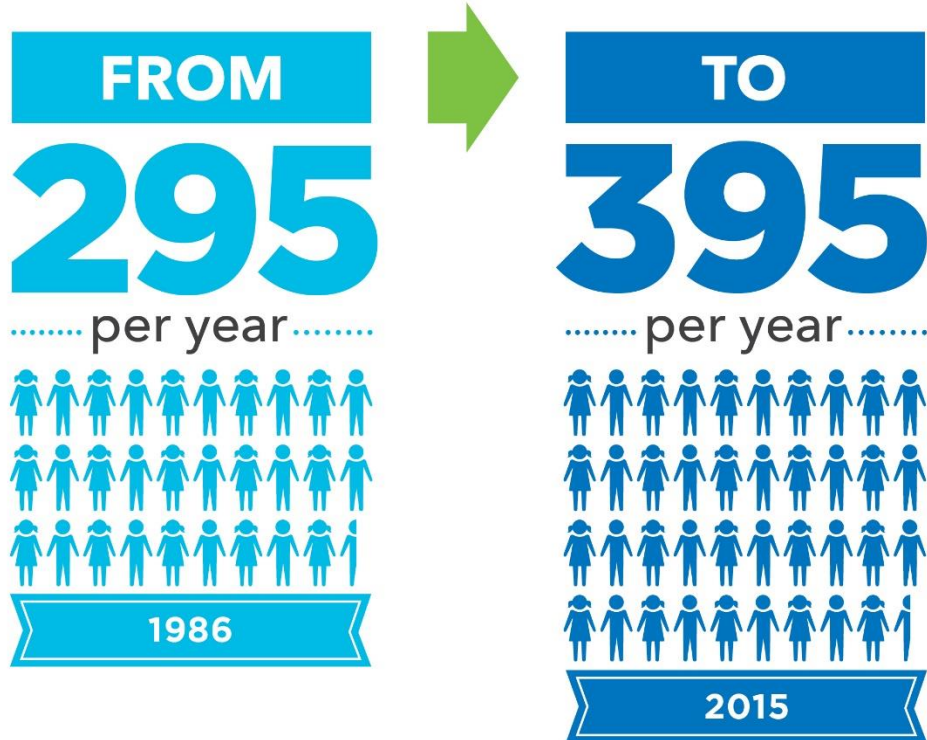


## INCIDENCE OF CHILDHOOD CANCER IN ONTARIO

**From 1986 to 2015, the average number of childhood cancer diagnoses increased**

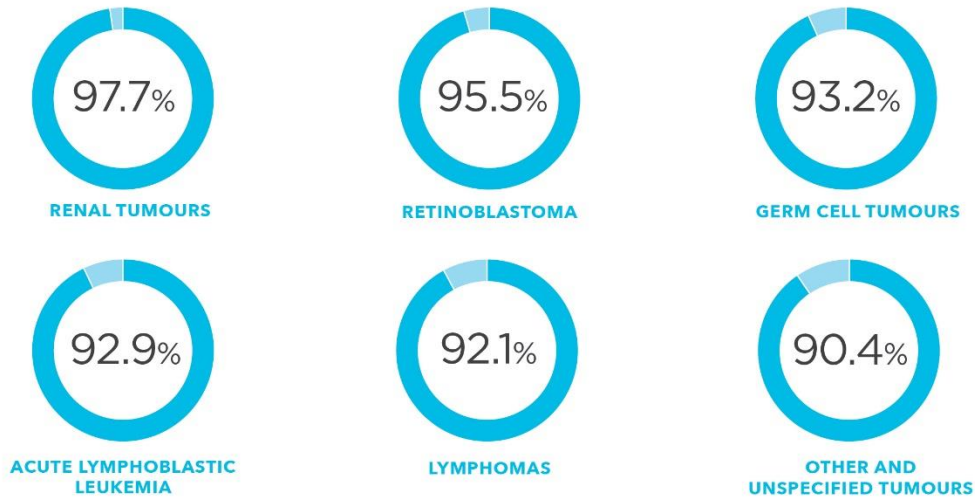


# CHILDHOOD CANCER SURVIVAL IN ONTARIO

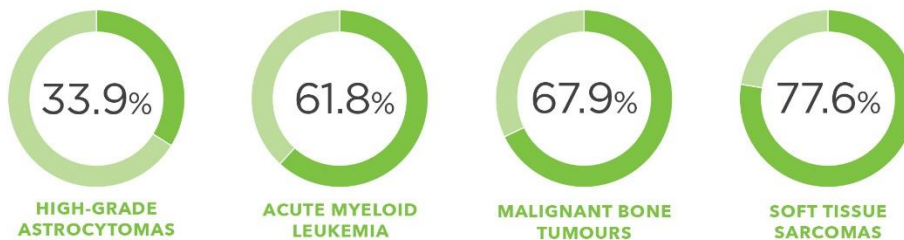
Survival rates are continuing to improve for many, but not all, types of childhood cancer.



## THE HIGHEST 5-YEAR OVERALL SURVIVAL RATE, 2011-2015

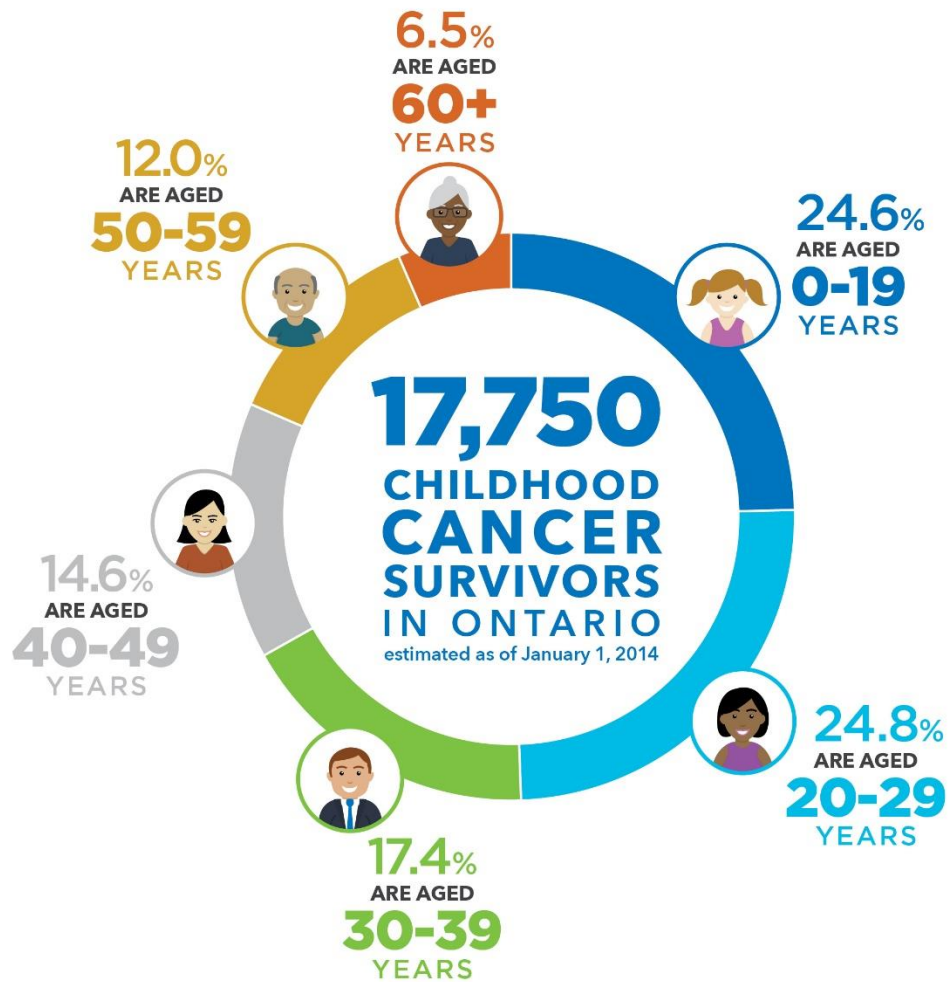


## THE POOREST 5-YEAR OVERALL SURVIVAL RATE, 2011-2015
