- ▶ We have had a total of 15,707 ambulatory clinic visits in our POGO Satellite Clinic program at Health Sciences North since we have been established.

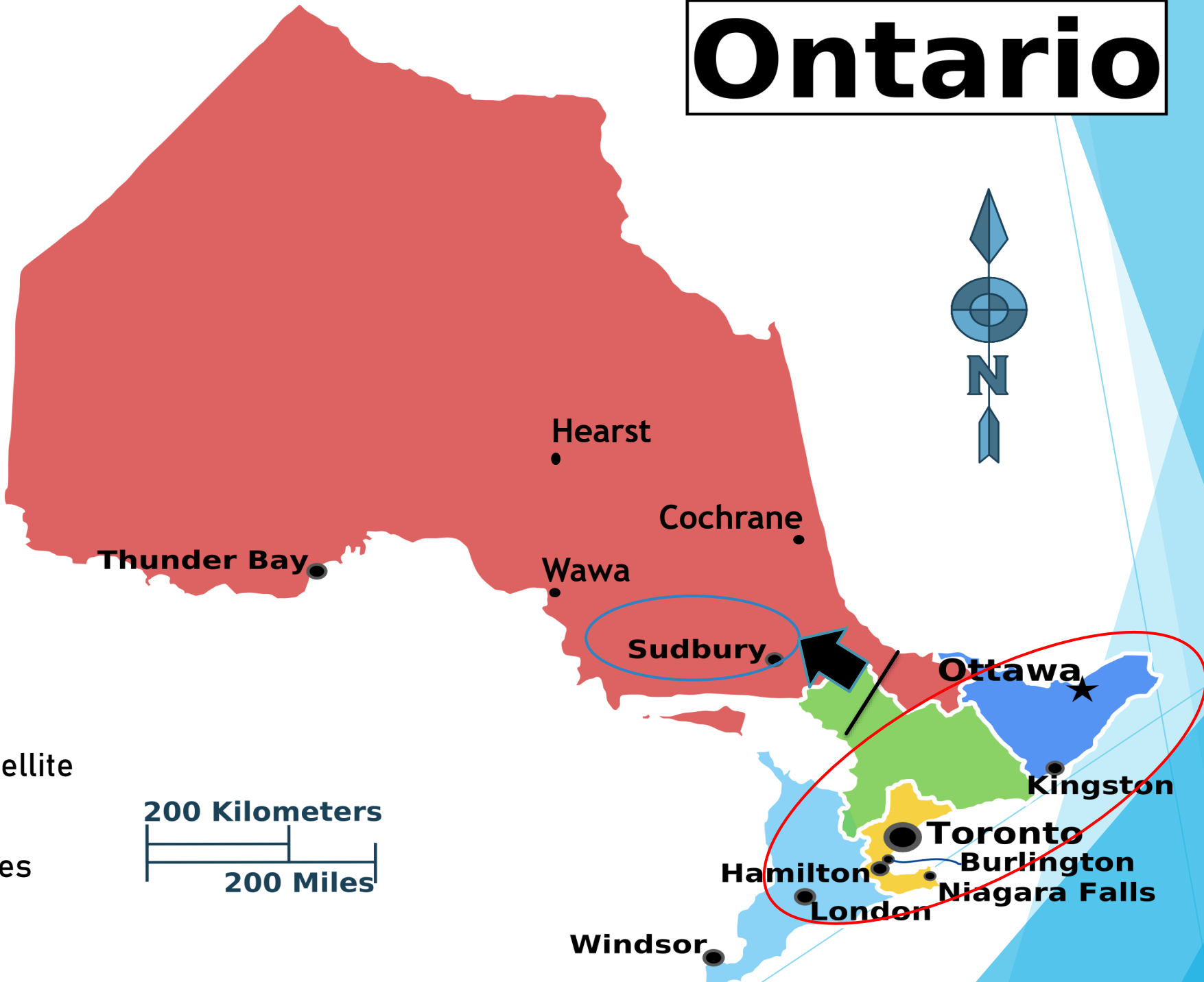
